

Section 3 – External Auditor Report and Certificate 2017/18

In respect of **Vale Of Allen Group of Local Councils DO0168**

1 Respective responsibilities of the body and the auditor

This authority is responsible for ensuring that its financial management is adequate and effective and that it has a sound system of internal control. The authority prepares an Annual Governance and Accountability Return in accordance with *Proper Practices* which:

- summarises the accounting records for the year ended 31 March 2018; and
- confirms and provides assurance on those matters that are relevant to our duties and responsibilities as external auditors.

Our responsibility is to review Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return in accordance with guidance issued by the National Audit Office (NAO) on behalf of the Comptroller and Auditor General (see note below). Our work **does not** constitute an audit carried out in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (UK & Ireland) and **does not** provide the same level of assurance that such an audit would do.

2 External auditor report 2017/18

Except for the matters reported below, on the basis of our review of Sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR), in our opinion the information in Sections 1 and 2 of the AGAR is in accordance with Proper Practices and no other matters have come to our attention giving cause for concern that relevant legislation and regulatory requirements have not been met.

The smaller authority failed to approve the AGAR in time to publish it before 2 July 2018, the date required by the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015, and did not disclose this by answering 'No' to Section 1, Box 1.

The smaller authority failed to publish the final signed AGAR by 30 September 2018, the date required by the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015, and did not disclose this by answering 'No' to Section 1, Box 1. This is as a result of the AGAR and additional documentation not being submitted for review until 14/12/18 and the appointed auditor not being able to then complete the review by this date.

Section 1, Assertion 5 has been incorrectly completed. The internal auditor noted in their detailed internal audit report that there was no evidence of the risk assessment being approved or carried out during the year under review. In our opinion the answer to this assertion should have been "No". The new clerk has notified us that action has since been taken to address this area of weakness.

The smaller authority did not arrange for an independent internal auditor to review the internal controls and give their conclusion in the Annual Internal Audit Report during 2017/18 and did not disclose this by answering 'No' to Section 1, Box 6.

The smaller authority did not prepare or submit an annual return for the previous year. As a result, we have been unable to verify the prior year figures.

Other matters not affecting our opinion which we draw to the attention of the authority:

We note that the smaller authority did not comply with Regulation 15 of the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2015 as it failed to make proper provision during the year 2018/19 for the exercise of public rights, since the period for the exercise of public rights did not include the first 10 working days of July. As a result, the smaller authority must answer 'No' to Assertion 4 of the Annual Governance Statement for 2018/19 and ensure that it makes proper provision for the exercise of public rights during 2019/20.

In the completion of the Annual Internal Audit Report, and their detailed reports, the internal auditor has drawn attention to significant weaknesses in relation to internal control objectives B and C, in respect of risk assessment and budget monitoring. The internal auditor also made a number of recommendations in respect of record keeping and approval processes. The new clerk has notified us that action has already been taken to address these areas of weakness.
